2. Reduce your use of water and electricity.
3. Place decals on windows to deter bird collisions.
4. Create a pollinator garden in your backyard.
5. Minimize use of herbicides and pesticides.
6. Slow down when driving.
7. Recycle and buy sustainable products. Keep trash out of the environment.
8. Never purchase products made from threatened or endangered species.
9. Do not harass wildlife.
10. Protect wildlife habitats.

10 Things You Can Do to Help Save Endangered Plants

1. Visit botanical gardens, arboreta, wildlife refuges, and other locations to learn about endangered plants.
2. Plant native plants.
3. Never harvest threatened or endangered plants.
4. Buy plants from reputable buyers.
5. Don't plant invasive plants.
6. Minimize use of herbicides and pesticides.
7. Buy reused wood or Forest Stewardship Council certified wood, highly recycled paper, and fair-trade coffee.
8. Don't drain wetlands habitats.
9. When choosing a first or second home, look for houses that are already built.
10. Don't destroy habitats.
